The Cultural Research Information Summary Program (CRISP) is an information tool for non-archaeological experts. It is useful for rapid assessment of potential project areas (PPA's). A PPA could be a contemplated well pad and road, a borrow pit, or any other action. CRISP users draw their PPA on a map image and then run a report on the PPA. CRISP is web-based, and uses cultural resource inventory layers, cultural resource summary layers, and cultural resource forecasts (models) to provide the user with a summary of knowledge about their PPA.

Information available on this website is being made accessible to facilitate in early project planning in regards to cultural resources. The information provided is a synthesis of inventory and site information and does not divulge any specific location of archeological or historic sites. CRISP does not replace consultation with appropriate agencies, landowners, land managers, and other participants in the cultural resource management process. CRISP does not replace discussions with cultural resource managers or other experts. What CRISP does is to provide is a way to gain a quick overview of what might be present on or in the ground, and information about what is already known.
